Postdoctoral Scholar Benefit Program Short-Term Disability Insurance

This program offered by Aetna Insurance provides you a way of protecting your income should you become disabled.

Though many of us feel that we will never be disabled, however almost 3 in 10 workers entering the work force today will become disabled before retiring (Social Security Administration Fact Sheet, January 31, 2007).

It is important to have a vehicle to offer protection to your income, to allow you to meet your financial obligations when you are unable to work. The Short-Term Disability insurance does just that.

The University pays for 100% of this benefit.

Please note: You are automatically enrolled in this benefit (postdocs in job codes 098203 and 098219 only) when you submit an enrollment application, even if you waive all other plans.

Postdoctoral Scholar Benefit Program Short-Term Disability Insurance (Cont.)

Benefit Amount

Your monthly benefit is 70 percent of your insured *predisability earnings*.

Plan Maximum Weekly Benefit: \$1,500

Benefit Waiting Period

If your claim is approved, benefits become payable after you have been continuously disabled for 8 days.

Maximum Benefit Period

STD benefits may continue during disability for up to 52 weeks.
