



First Health Network FAQs

Q *What is First Health?*

A First Health makes a national network available to Health Net, with doctors and hospitals located throughout the U.S. This arrangement allows you, as a Health Net PPO member, to receive health care services at a contracted rate, whether you reside or travel outside of California.

Q *When do I use the Health Net PPO Network, and when do I use the First Health Network?*

A California resident members – when in California – should use the Health Net PPO Network, and when traveling outside of California, should use the First Health Network.

If you are on an out-of-state (OOS) plan – and reside outside of California – you should use the First Health Network all the time, even when in California.

Helpful examples

Travel benefit:

Sue (employee) has a CA SBG PPO plan and lives in California:

- When Sue is at home in California, she uses her CA Health Net PPO Network to get in-network benefits.
- When Sue visits her son in Idaho (who is a dependent on her plan), she uses the First Health Network to get in-network services.
- This also applies to Sue's son. Even though he lives in Idaho, he accesses care via Sue's travel benefit, using the First Health Network.
- When Sue's son comes home to visit his mom in California, he would use the CA Health Net PPO Network to access in-network care.

OOS resident benefit:

Brad has a CA SBG PPO OOS plan and lives in Nevada.

- When Brad is at home in Nevada, he uses the First Health Network to get in-network services.
- When Brad is anywhere in the United States – even in California – he uses the First Health Network to get in-network services.

Q *How do I find a First Health Network provider?*

A You can call First Health at 1-800-226-5116. You can also log in to your www.healthnet.com member account, click on *ProviderSearch* and then on *Search First Health* to find a provider online (see attached flyer). **Note:** In order to access the accurate list of Health Net-contracted First Health providers, you must use the link on HealthNet.com.

Q *What type of care can I get from First Health?*

A You can only access medical services from First Health Network providers.

- For mental health services, you should contact MHN at the number on your ID card.
- For acupuncture and chiropractic benefits, you should contact American Specialty Health Networks (ASH) at 1-800-678-9133.

Q *How do I verify a provider is in-network?*

A You should ask the provider's office personnel if they contract with First Health. (The First Health logo is on the your ID card.)

Q *What should I do if a provider states they are out-of-network but they show as in-network on the website?*

A You can call First Health at 1-800-226-5116. The customer service agent should be able to verify contract status or help you find another provider that is contracted and meets your care needs.

Q *How do I get services authorized?*

A Authorizations should be requested on your behalf by the facility/physician that would perform the services.

Authorizations are requested from the following avenues

Outpatient pharmaceutical submitted under the medical benefit:

Health Net's Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) – 1-800-548-5524

Radiation therapy and sleep studies:

Advanced imaging:

National Imaging Associates (NIA) – 1-800-424-4802

For all other authorizations:

Health Net Life Insurance Company – 1-800-977-7282, fax 1-800-793-4473

Note: This list is not all-inclusive of services that require authorization.

Q *What happens if I receive care from a provider that is not contracted with First Health?*

A You may have to pay higher out-of-pocket costs at the time of service and will then need to submit a [claim form](#) to receive reimbursement at the out-of-network benefit level, subject to any applicable copayment, coinsurance and deductible.

Q *How do I find a network pharmacy?*

A Members can visit www.healthnet.com/mypharmacy and click on *Find a pharmacy* at the bottom of the page to locate an in-network pharmacy near your home or work.

Q *What can I do in case of an emergency?*

A You should go to the nearest emergency room, even if it is not a contracted First Health provider.

Q *How can I get a cost estimate for services in advance of receiving services?*

A You can contact the provider for a cost estimate. You can also call Health Net and get help with questions regarding coverage and benefit levels.

Q *How can I request that a provider be added to the First Health Network?*

A You can complete the [Provider Nomination Form](#) to request that a provider be added to the First Health Network. Instructions for submission are listed on the form.

Q *Does the Health Net PPO service area include U.S. territories?*

A The Health Net PPO service area is the continental United States. This does not include U.S. territories or Hawaii. However, if you are a California resident and travel to Hawaii, you can access a First Health provider at in-network benefits.

Q *How many providers are in the First Health Network?*

A Approximately 868,000. See the attached chart for a breakdown of providers by state and specialty.

Q *Does Health Net contract with all providers in the First Health Network?*

A No, we do not. Specifically, certain toxicology labs and Mayo Clinic providers are excluded from our First Health agreement.

These providers are excluded:

- SMA Medical Lab
- Millennium Health
- Precision Toxicology
- Confirmatrix Lab
- Vitae Diagnostics
- John Granger
- Mayo

To get started:

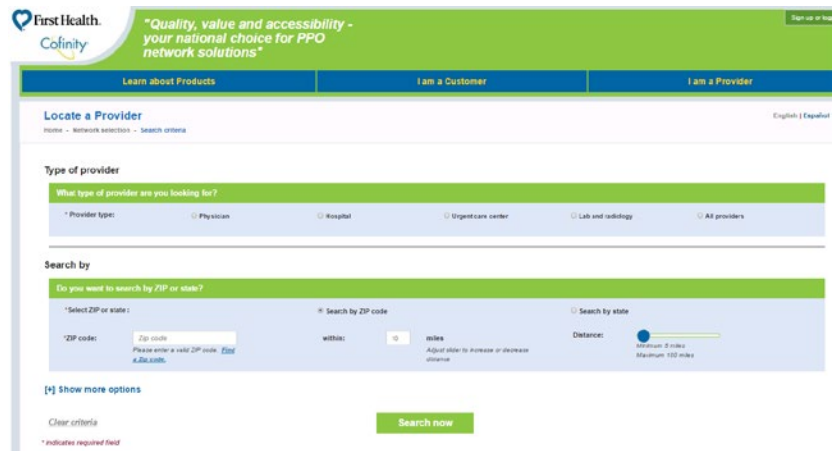
Select “National PPO - First Health” on your Health Net provider search site

Click the “Start now” button

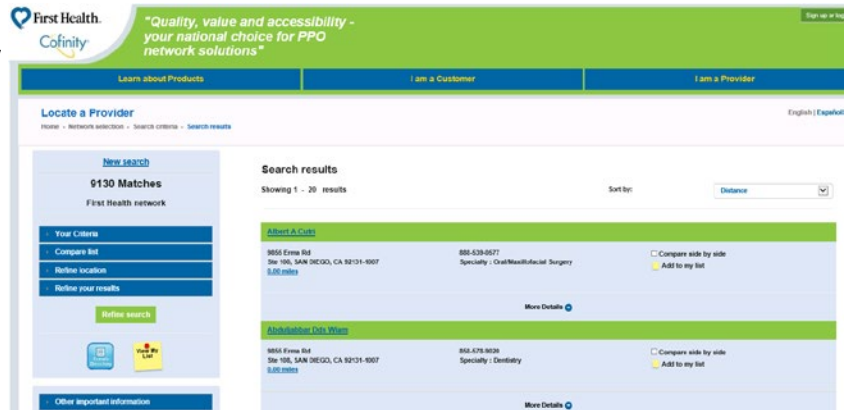
Choose your criteria:

Provider counts are as of March 2018 from First Health data warehouse. Physicians with multiple locations are counted once per region. Other hospitals include mental health/substance abuse centers, pediatric, rehabilitation, specialty and women's hospitals. Other ancillary locations include all other facility providers not otherwise categorized. Information is believed to be accurate as of production date, however, it is subject to change.
