Type of Provider Type of Illness or Injury Scenario **Primary Care Physician (PCP)** Annual wellness exams, or moderate pain you General checkup, moderate pain of need diagnosed unknown origin, etc. (Common under HMO plan) Experiencing pain specific to a particular region of Specialist Ulcers, rash, digestive problems, vision the body (i.e. muscular, gastrointestinal, ocular, problems, elevated levels, etc. (Requires referral from PCP under HMO) bone/joint, skin, ears/nose/throat, etc.) Having an inpatient or outpatient procedure Delivering a baby, major/minor surgery, Hospital performed, in a critical state recovery, monitoring, etc. Treatment of unscheduled, non-emergency Vaccination, mild cold/flu, minor cuts/ Walk-in Clinic illnesses/injuries and certain immunizations abrasions, etc. Broken bones (not multiple fractures), **Urgent Care** Treatment of most non-life threatening minor wounds (not bleeding profusely), emergencies (Alternative to ER) mild fever, flu, acute sinusitis, etc. Severe head trauma, multiple/compound Treatment of all life/limb-threatening **Emergency Room (ER)** fractures, heavy bleeding, elevated fever, emergencies severe burns, seizures, poison, etc.
